IVORY FISH LURES



Fish lure in the form of a sculpin, 7.4 cm Top and bottom views - for details, see following page.



From near Teller, Alaska, 10.1 cm (some holes still retain baleen inserts).



In this fish lure (8.7 cm), excavated at Wales, Alaska together with the lure shown at the top of the preceding page, there are large empty holes for previously inlaid eyes, a characteristic feature of sculpin-form lures. Similar 6-7 mm diameter holes are drilled part way into their bottom surfaces, for reasons that remain unclear.
